It is provided by both public and private higher vocational colleges. The practice orientated programmes extend over 2 years and emerge out of actual economic staffing needs. The students develop vocational competences in accordance to vocational standards. The graduates are qualified to manage, plan, and supervise work processes.</p> <p>The short-cycle higher vocational education, in Slovenia too, has been interrelating increasingly to the international environment, and its development has been under great influence of the Bologna declaration and the Copenhagen declaration. To implement freedom of movement of persons and recognition of vocational qualifications in the EU member states, the law states explicitly that the vocational standards and study programmes shall be comparable at the European level. The responsible authorities promote and encourage the combined study programmes and programmes of continuous training and/or lifelong training.</p>
